

Opposite Adjectives Dominoes 1

Introduction

This engaging dominoes activity helps students learn adjectives and their opposites.

Before the Lesson

Print (A4 size), laminate, and cut out the domino cards on the dotted cut lines. In lieu of laminating, print on thicker A4 cardstock paper. Be sure to print enough copies for the amount of students you have, *for example, if you have 15 students in class, print the pdf five times and group students into threes.*

In the Lesson

Provide each group of students a set of the dominoes. Explain that they are to match the adjectives with their opposites, making a rectangle to connect all of the cards.

Once the students have connected all of the dominoes, extend the activity by creating sentences using all of the adjectives. Write the sentences that the students create on the board, or have the students come up and write the sentences themselves.

Vocabulary practice	To learn 20 adjectives and their opposites.	A1/A2	30-40 minutes with extension activity.



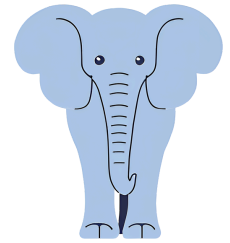
