

Question Words 1

Introduction

This worksheet helps students practice using question words *who*, *what*, *where*, *when*, *why*, and *how*.

In the Lesson

Provide each student with a copy of the two-page worksheet.

In Exercise 1, students will fill in the blanks with the appropriate question words. Then, in Exercise 2, they will match the corresponding answers to the questions.

For Exercise 3, students will pair up to ask and answer the questions from Exercise 2, taking note of four responses from their partner. After everyone has completed this, invite students to share four interesting facts about their partner with the class.

In Exercise 4, students will tackle a crossword puzzle, which they can complete individually or collaboratively with a partner.

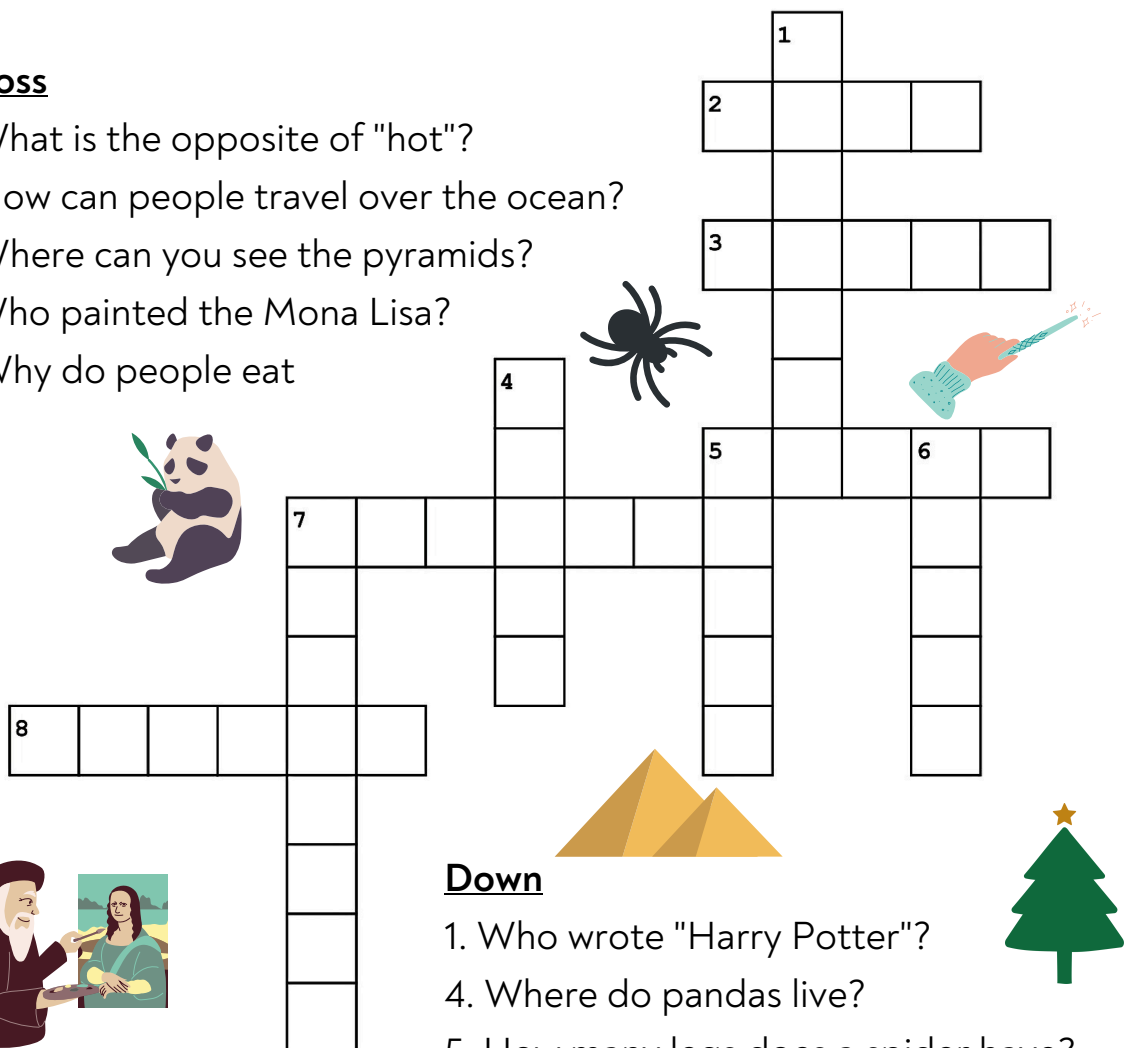
