

Present Progressive 1

Introduction

This worksheet helps students further their knowledge of the present progressive tense.

In the Lesson

Provide each student with a copy of the two-page worksheet.

Before diving into the exercises, ensure that you review how to form the Present Progressive tense.

In Exercise 1, students will complete the sentences by using the present progressive form of the given verbs.

For Exercise 2, students will write their own sentences to go with the pictures. Answers can deviate from the answer key. To extend the exercise, have students give you a negative sentence for each picture, e.g. The couple isn't hiking up a mountain.

In Exercise 3, students will form questions with the provided set of words.

Exercise 4 allows students to engage in asking and answering questions with a partner or as a class. Be sure to allocate sufficient time for discussion.
