Introduction

This worksheet helps students practice countable and uncontable nouns.

In the Lesson

Provide each student with a copy of the two-page worksheet.

'COUNTABLE + UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS'


When it comes to nouns, they can be categorized as either countable or uncountable.
